



## **Orston Shooting Competitions – March '21**

As Orston Shooting Ground continues to evolve and adapt with the coronavirus situation, we will continue to run our competitions, all of which can be viewed and booked online. The below set of rules run in accordance with our standard terms and conditions which can be seen online.

What you need to know to come and shoot competitions:

- You can shoot however many competitions you wish!
- All entrants MUST be pre-booked. This can be done online by visiting <https://competitionandeventsschedule.orston.com/>
- All entrants must be CPSA members. If you're not a CPSA member you must be a license holder and must shoot the competition B/O and let us know this at point of booking (which is asked online)
- Sporting will be squadded, with a scorer taking you from stand to stand in order from stands 1-13. There will be a maximum 5 persons making up the squad and a scorer. ESP squad times will be available 9am to 2.40pm. We will be squadding you with other persons if your individual group is of less than 5 people which you have access to and can be seen online.
- Sport Trap will be squadded (max 5 per squad) with one scorer. You will be required to move from layout to layout, maintaining social distancing. Sport Trap squad times will be available 9am to 3pm every 20 minutes.
- Compak (and the Orston Masters) will be 6 person squads with a button pusher and a referee. These persons will be a suitable distance away from the squad in order to comply with social distancing measures.
- The Clay Shooting Classic will be run with referees on each stand, with squads moving as a group from one stand to the next.
- Please read the latest information attached relating to ESP and STR from the CPSA of which shooters must adhere to. Control measures will be in place from Orston Shooting Ground.

- You must arrive 15 minutes prior to your allocated start time and be at the designated “waiting point” 5 minutes before your start time on either Sporting (near Stand 1) or STR (TBC in clubhouse window).
- All Prize money will be available to collect in from reception. It may be in cash or cheque form. In the event that it is in cheque form and you wish to cash it in for a future shoot, this can be arranged. Please see the office staff.
- Anyone who is late will forfeit their allotted time with no refund given.
- Only score cards will be handled by the scorers. An agreed verbal score will be given at the end of each stand/layout.
- All results will be available 2 hours after the last squad has completed on each respective course and will be posted on our shooting ground Facebook page, on our website in addition to the results being sent to the CPSA.
- All those on site must abide by social distancing guidelines and verbally agree on booking to our Covid-19 customer agreement statement as well as our safe shooting policy which can be seen in reception.
- Ammunition can be purchased prior to arrival or on the day.
- We ask that you do not wait around once your shooting has concluded and you operate a shoot and go policy.
- If you are shooting more than one competition, we ask that you wait in your vehicle between your shooting times.
- The café will be open on Saturdays and Sundays with a limited take away menu. We ask that you follow procedures and staff instructions to ensure that social distancing is maintained whilst food is served.
- Practice will be available throughout the grounds. Please see the office staff for more information of whats available on the day.
- We advise everyone coming to Orston SG to bring their own PPE. Hand sanitising points will be located at a number of areas around the grounds which we ask you to use them regularly especially on arrival and upon leaving.
- You do not need to come to reception providing payment has been given.

- Squad lists and layouts will be available to view from the outside of the clubhouse and referees will meet you at your designated starting points before briefing you prior to starting on your relevant shooting layout.
- If bringing guests with you, we ask you to keep this to a minimum and this to only happen if essential. In the event this does happen individuals must be at least 2 metres away from all members of public at all times whilst shooting.
- The clubhouse will be open. We currently have in place a one way system, with toilets open.
- The shop is open on a click and collect basis until the 12<sup>th</sup> April , when we will re-open in a more 'normal' way with restrictions in place.
